

NSO SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA FACILITATES EMIRATI COMPOSER DEBUT IN FLORENCE

Pianist Hamad Altaee performs with Orchestra da Camera Fiorentina

Abu Dhabi, UAE. 28 March 2018 – In a cross-cultural collaboration, the NSO

Symphony Orchestra's Music Director, Andrew Berryman, conducted the Orchestra da Camera Fiorentina in Florence, Italy, on 25 March, in a concert that featured NSO Principal Flutist Christian Plouvier and Emirati Composer and Pianist, Hamad Altaee, performing his own compositions for piano and orchestra.

For the first time for an Emirati musician in Italy, Hamad performed his compositions, which included Le Cheval and Journey of Life.

NSO Music Director Andrew Berryman conducted the 16-piece string ensemble, the Orchestra da Camera Fiorentina at the Auditorium di Santo Stefano al Ponte in Florence, which was attended by music enthusiasts, including the UAE Consulate General to Rome Italy, His Excellency Mr Sager Nasser Ahmed Abdullah Al Raisi.

NSO's participation in the concert was a cross-cultural collaboration, following a visit by Giuseppe Lanzetta, Music Director for Orchestra da Camera Fiorentina, who conducted works during NSO's concert in November 2017, A Night at the Symphony, at Abu Dhabi's Emirates Palace Hotel Auditorium.

NSO Founder & Executive Director, Mrs Janet Hassouneh, said: "It was a tremendous honour for NSO to participate in a concert by one of Florence's leading orchestras. I was especially pleased to present Hamad Altaee, as the first UAE composer to perform to an Italian audience. He performed magnificently and his compositions were received enthusiastically.

Meetings were held with Prof. Paolo Ciardi, Director of the prestigious Conservatorio di Musica "Luigi Cherubini", who invited both Hamad, Maestro Berryman and Flutist

Mr. Plouvier to perform with the conservatories own orchestra later in 2018 and hold master classes for their students. NSO hopes this cross-cultural collaboration will become a tradition for both parties in years to come."

Hamad Altaee is a pilot and, in his free time, plays piano and composes music. He finds his greatest inspiration to write music is when he's flying and discovering the planet. Hamad says his goal is to share his happiness, simplicity and positivity with everyone he meets along the way.

Over the past seven years, NSO has performed superb orchestral pieces in concert, such as, Tchaikovsky's 4th and 5th symphonies, Bernstein's West Side Story Symphonic Dances, and a full production of the opera Hansel & Gretel.

The orchestra has also been contracted to accompany Andrea Bocelli when he sang for some 10,000 people at du Arena in 2016, and to perform live at the screening of Disney's animated film, *Frozen*, in 2016, the BBC's The Blue Planet with Sir George Fenton for the opening ceremony of the Volvo Ocean Race in 2014, at the World Skills event in 2017, and to worldwide TV audiences such as the World Cup horseracing extravaganza in 2014.

NSO Symphony Orchestra will perform publicly for the last time on Friday 27 April. The evening gala on Friday 27 April is at 7.30pm; younger adults may like to attend the matinee at 4.30pm, which is also an 'open rehearsal', a fascinating opportunity to watch the orchestra and chorus at work and see how a piece of music is shaped and polished by Maestro Berryman and the musicians as they prepare for the gala evening. If possible, the conductor and artists may speak to the attendees following the rehearsal.

NSO's season finale is sponsored by Abu Dhabi media hub <u>twofour54</u> as Presenting Sponsor, in addition to Platinum Sponsors <u>Gulf Capital</u>, <u>Abu Dhabi Classic FM</u>, and <u>Emirates Palace Hotel</u>. Entrepreneur and former Opera Singer Janet Hassouneh founded NSO in 2011 to meet the region's cultural aspirations. Originally from the USA, where she obtained her master's in musical performance, she has worked in the music business in the UAE for the past 30 years, performing, teaching and organising music theatre and opera concerts featuring international guest artists from New York and London. Numerous performances were staged for charitable causes, under the auspices of the UAE authorities. NSO UAE was formed to reciprocate the government's hospitality.
